

PRAYER FOCUS: On 10 December, people around the world mark **Human Rights Day**. Human rights protected by the European Convention on Human Rights (ECHR) include the rights to life, free elections, a fair trial, freedom of expression, freedom of thought, conscience and religion, freedom from torture and freedom from discrimination. Last month, representatives of the Baptist, Methodist and United Reformed Churches signed a letter speaking up for human rights. God – three in one, dialogue united, speak into the heart of our politics, that we might love others as you first loved us. In Jesus' name, Amen We also pray for everyone living or working in **Belmont Road, Pennor Drive, Trelevan Gardens, Colenso Place, Bossiney Road** and **Boconnoc Road**
